Getting the most out of your time at Origins:

The best thing you can do for yourself and others is to be fully present during the gathering. That means everyone in the room being **as free from distractions as possible**. Here's how you can help:

1. If you need to smoke or "vape" please do so outside, on the east side of the building, before or after the gathering only.
2. Tune in during the music. We want you to participate!
3. Limit your movement during the gathering. Get your coffee and use the restroom before the gathering.
4. Avoid excessive talking. Sound carries very well anywhere in the building and is louder and more distracting than you may realize.
5. Guide your children. Except when they are in their Origins Kidz classes, we ask that they remain with you at all times.
